## BRIEF HISTORY OF EGERTON UNIVERSITY

Egerton University started as an Agricultural school in 1939, when it admitted the first three students in makeshift premises.

Since then, it has become an acknowledged degree awarding institution with a reputation as a Centre of Excellence in Agricultural Training. It also offers various courses in Education, Natural and Applied Science, Health, Arts and Social Science.

The first three students of the institution were ex-world war II British servicemen who required basic training in agriculture prior to settling in the Kenya Highlands. The mode of instructions at Egerton Agricultural College remained informal until the mid-1940's when a formal nine-month certificate course was introduced. The school was subsequently elevated to an Agricultural college. A diploma programme was initiated in 1949 and in 1955, the Government handed the management of the college to a Board of Governors through an Act of Parliament.

In 1986, the college was elevated to a constituent college of the University of Nairobi and in 1987 it was granted University status by an Act of Parliament.

The university has two campuses, one college campus and three constituent Colleges. The Main Campus (Njoro Campus), is located 180 kilometers North West of Nairobi and about 30 kilometers from Nakuru on a 144 - hectare piece of land donated by Lord Maurice Egerton of Tatton (1874 - 1958). This Campus is situated at an altitude of approximately 2,250 metres, with excellent climate, ideal for serious academic pursuit.

The college campus is located in Nakuru Town and offers self-sponsored degree programmes in Business, Engineering and Arts. The University Medical School is also situated in Nakuru town. It offers training at undergraduate level in Medicine, and Nursing.

Kenyatta Campus is being developed into a center for Open and Distance Learning and is situated 5 km. from Njoro campus.

Laikipia University College) is located near Nyahururu town some 45 kilometres from Nakuru, on a 365 - hectare piece of land formerly occupied by Laikipia Teachers College.

This college, among others, offers Bachelors Degree in Education (Arts) and the Postgraduate Diploma courses in education which are offered to aspiring secondary school teachers..

Kisii University College is situated in Kisii town on a 24 - Hecate piece of land formerly occupied by Kisii Teachers College.

Chuka University College is situated in Chuka town in Eastern Kenya.

Since its inauguration Egerton University has continued to expand. It has 42 departments in eight faculties with 3,181 staff members (academic, administrative and support) and about 13,000 students pursuing various undergraduate, diploma, and postgraduate degree programmes.

The University has a vibrant Research and Extension division which enhances an interface between training, research and the wider community.

## THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

About twenty years ago, in the month of February 1984 former students of Egerton College got together and formed an organization, with the following objectives:

**Promoting** the image, integrity and principles of Egerton University as an institution of higher learning, especially in the field of Agriculture; **disseminating** agricultural information to rural areas so as to enhance agricultural development in Kenya; **promoting** exchange of socio-cultural ideas among Alumni and the University community through seminars, tours and meetings; **soliciting** support from the public and private sectors to further develop the university; **acquiring and disseminating** information of employment opportunities for Alumni; rewarding students/Alumni for exemplary scholarship; **promoting** qualitative research within the university, enhancing publication and dissemination of educational materials within the university, **organizing** income generating activities with the aim of raising funds for the development of the university and ; **assisting** in decision making in the university.

In April 2005, the Alumni Services and Student Placement office, and the Alumni Association Office were merged into one, in order to refocus the Alumni Activities within the University. A coordinator assisted by an administrative unit is in-charge of all Alumni activities with the university.

By linking with the Alumni all over the world, this office provides an opportunity for the university to get feedback from the business world regarding its graduates. It is hoped that, the Alumni will not only help in the development of the university curriculum, so that it is more responsive to industry needs but will also help in infrastructure development.

Membership into the organization is open to all Egerton University graduates, academic and administrative staff and individuals and organizations committed to development of the University. Life membership fee is Ksh 5,000 while ordinary membership; renewable annually is only Ksh 200.

The association welcomes all Egerton University Alumni and friends of Egerton to join the organization, for together, we can forge forward better.

Democratically elected officials, who hold office for three years, manage the association. Registered members are eligible for election into the executive board. The executive committee elects two members to represent the Alumni interests in the University Council.
