## A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

---

In 1939 Lord Egerton of Tatton donated 320 hectares of land to the Department of Agriculture for the establishment of an Agricultural School! The first Buildings were constructed in 1940/1941 and first 3 students were admitted in 1941. Those early students were British ex-service men returning from World War II who were being prepared for farming in the Kenya Highlands. Initially, courses were informal and only in the mid 1940s were formal 9 months certificate Courses introduced. In 1949 the Diploma in Agriculture was initiated.

In 1955 the Government handed over the Management of the College to a Board of Governors. When Lord Egerton died in 1958, he left the College a further 1125 hectares of land.

In 1960, when it was obvious that Kenya's political independence was inevitable, the constitution had to be amended and the Board reorganized to allow the College, which was up till then an exclusive European preserve, to admit non-European students beginning 1961.

Training was also focused more sharply on the needs and aspirations of an independent Kenya.

The College has continued to grow in student numbers, staff, physical facilities as well as in the number and type of specialist courses offered. Today, there are 1,260 students drawn from Kenya and 10 other African countries studying 16 different Diploma courses. The present College plan envisages a student enrolment of 1632 by 1984/85 academic year.

This phenomenal growth is a reflection of the importance Kenya attaches to agricultural development and the readiness with which Egerton College has been able to respond to the national aspirations.
